Project Brief of Advance Works for Western Market

1. Project Background

1.1 Western Market originally consisted of two separate blocks: the South Block on Queen's Road Central which was erected in 1858 and demolished in 1980 and the North Block which was built in 1906. The North Block was identified by the Antiquities and Monuments Office (AMO) as one of the declared monuments in Hong Kong in 1990. The former Land Development Corporation (LDC) converted the market into a centre of traditional traders, arts and crafts in 1991 and renamed it as "the Western Market".

The latest major renovation and refurbishment works of Western Market were carried out in 2003 by the Authority, and since then there have been only minor repairs and routine maintenance. Therefore, to maintain fair building condition of Western Market, the improvement works ("the Works") is tentatively scheduled to commence in Q2 2025.

2. Scope of Works

The scope of the Works generally includes the following:

- 2.1 Repair Works
- 2.1.1 Repairing works or re-roofing of the existing pitched roof and flat roofs;
- 2.1.2 Repairing works to existing wall bricks, structures, canopies, cornices, mouldings, window heads, window sills and making good/repainting brick
- 2.1.3 Repairing works to existing doors, louvers and windows; and
- 2.1.4 Repairing works on existing roof gutter and rainwater downpipes.
- 2.2 A&A Works
- 2.2.1 Replacement of escalator with associated builder's works;
- 2.2.2 Removal/Re-partitioning and reinstatement of the existing shops and kitchens in bare shell;
- 2.2.3 Replacement of existing wooden louvers by wooden windows;
- 2.2.4 Renovation of lift lobbies;
- 2.2.5 Lift modernization works;
- 2.2.6 Provision of a new façade lighting system; and
- 2.2.7 E&M services such as replacement of VESDA panel, general lighting and power provision with all necessary accessories, public address system, broadcast system, closed-circuit televisions, plumbing & drainage system and MVAC system including overhaul of existing chiller system.

3. Shortlisting Criteria

- 3.1 The contractor shall be on the Development Bureau's list of Approved Contractors for Public Works in Group B or Group C, either confirmed or at probationary status, in the category of 'Buildings' and acting as Registered General Building Contractors ("RGBC") under the Buildings Ordinance;
- 3.2 The contractor shall have at least one (1) job reference of new building project or retrofiting works or addition and alteration (A&A) works in Hong Kong with the contract value not less than HK\$70 million completed in the past 10 years before the closing date of the pre-qualification or in progress;
- 3.3 The contractor shall have at least one (1) job reference of addition and alteration (A&A) works or renovation works for historic buildings or declared monuments (see Note 1 below) in Hong Kong, in the capacity of the main contractor and acting as registered general building contractor ("RGBC") under the Buildings Ordinance with the contract value not less than HK\$30 million completed in the past 15 years before the closing date of the prequalification or in progress;
- 3.4 The contractor shall have at least one authorized signatory (see Note 2 below) registered with the Buildings Department in respect of its general building contractor registration;
- 3.5 The latest performance record of the contractor in the Authority's self-developed projects, if any, in the past one (1) year before the closing date of the pre-qualification shall not be marginal performance or below; and
- 3.6 The contractor shall not be under suspension or restriction (including voluntary suspension or restriction) from tendering under any of the relevant lists of the Government, the Hong Kong Housing Authority or the Hong Kong Housing Society at the closing date of the pre-qualification.

Note:-

- 'Historic buildings' means any of the 1,444 historic buildings or 429 new items as referred to in the "Results of the Assessment of 1,444 Historic Buildings and New Items" (up to 28 June 2024) on the webpage of the Antiquities Advisory Board and 'declared monuments' means any of the 134 declared monuments in Hong Kong (as at 20 October 2023) as referred to on the webpage of the Antiquities and Monuments Office.
- 2. As mentioned on the website of the Buildings Department, if no authorized signatory acts for a registered contractor for the purpose of the Buildings Ordinance, the registered contractor must cease all building works and street works under the Buildings Ordinance immediately.
- 3 If the contractor is a limited company, only one company from the contractor or its associated companies (as defined in Section 2(1) of the Companies Ordinance (Cap. 622)) will be shortlisted. In the event of PQ submissions received from the contractor and its associated companies, the Authority will follow up with them to seek the confirmation of which one of them to apply for pre-qualification for the Works.

If the contractors fail to respond or otherwise, fail to decide which company to be chosen for the application of PQ, the contractor whose company name ranks first in alphabetical order and complies with the above-mentioned shortlisting criteria will be shortlisted.

4 If the contractor is not a specialist contractor under the Development Bureau's list of approved suppliers of materials and specialist contractors for public works in the category of 'repair and restoration of historic buildings', the contractor shall engage a specialist contractor under the abovementioned list to carry out the repair and restoration works. Such requirement will be included in the tender document.
