# Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 109th Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 109<sup>th</sup> meeting on 29 March 2012 (Thursday) at URA's Head Office. The meeting was Chaired by Mr Barry Cheung and attended by 3 executive directors, 14 non-executive directors and a number of representatives from Management. The agenda items discussed and major decisions reached are highlighted below.

#### Achievement of Corporate Objectives for 1 April 2011 to 31 March 2012

The Board was appreciative of URA's wide-ranging achievements made in the past year especially the expeditious implementation of policy initiatives in the new Urban Renewal Strategy including demand-led redevelopment, facilitating services and flat-for-flat pilot schemes. 4. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the principal tender terms proposed in the Board paper for the joint venture development of Pak Tai Street/ Mok Cheong Street Project, and authorised Management to determine the final tender invitation programme.
