Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 167th Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 167th meeting on 30 April 2019 (Tuesday) at URA's Head Office. The meeting was chaired by Mr Victor So and attended by 3 executive directors, 17 non-executive directors and a number of representatives from Management. 7. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the submission to the Town Planning Board of a draft development scheme plan for a 2019/20 Business Plan project, as proposed in the Board paper.
