Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 178th Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 178th meeting on 10 June 2021 (Thursday) at URA's Head Office. The meeting was chaired by Mr Chow Chung-kong and attended by 3 executive directors, 17 non-executive directors and a number of representatives from the Management. The agenda items discussed and major decisions reached are highlighted below.

Tender Award for Oak Street / Ivy Street Project
