Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 184th Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 184th meeting on 3 March 2022 (Thursday) at URA's Head Office. The meeting was chaired by Mr Chow Chung-kong and attended by 3 executive directors, 18 non-executive directors and a number of representatives from the Management. The agenda items discussed and major decisions reached are highlighted below.

<u>Tender Award for Wing Kwong Street / Kai Ming Street / Hung Fook Street</u> <u>Projects</u>

2. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the acceptance of the highest tender proposal received for the joint venture development of four combined projects at Wing Kwong Street / Kai Ming Street / Hung Fook Street, as recommended by the relevant Tender Review Panel previously established by the Board. Following the approval, <u>Members</u> noted that the successful tenderer was Centenary Investments Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of CK Asset Holdings Limited.

Draft Development Scheme Plan for Business Plan Project

3. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved submission to the Town Planning Board of a draft development scheme plan for a 2022/23 Business Plan project, as proposed in the Board paper.

Principal Tender Terms for Sung Hing Lane / Kwai Heung Street Project

4. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the principal tender terms proposed in the Board paper for the joint venture development of Sung Hing Lane / Kwai Heung Street Project, and authorized the Management to determine the final tender invitation programme.

Extension of Rent Relief Measures

5. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved extension of rent relief measures to assist the tenants in URA's self-owned and joint venture properties.
