# Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 191<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 191<sup>st</sup> meeting on 11 May 2023 (Thursday) at URA's Head Office. 4. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the recommendation of the Ad Hoc Committee on the establishment of a funding mechanism in respect to the second endowment to Urban Renewal Fund, as set out in the Board paper.

#### 2023/24 Budget

5. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the URA's 2023/24 Budget as presented in the Board paper.

#### Appointment of Statutory Auditor

6. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the appointment of KPMG as the Statutory Auditor of URA for a 7-year period commencing from 2023/24, as proposed in the Board paper.

#### Application for a Property Management Company Licence under URA

7. After deliberations, <u>the Board</u> approved the application for a Property Management Company licence under URA, as recommended in the Board paper.

## **Extension of Rent Relief Measures**
